Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of G.D Memorial Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital East Ram Krishna Nagar, P.O. Jaganpura Patna -800027 with intake capacity of 100 seats in BHMS course and 42 seats in PG (Hom) in 7 subjects namely Homoeopathic Philosophy 06 seats, Materia Medica 06 seats, Repertory 06 seats, Pharmacy 06 seats, Practice of medicine 06 seats, Pediatrics 06 seats and Psychiatry 06 seats for the academic year 2024-2025 regarding.

G.D Memorial Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital East Ram Krishna Nagar, P.O. Jaganpura Patna -800027 functioning since 2001 and has applied for permission for continuing of BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 42 seats in PG (Hom) in 7 subjects namely Homoeopathic Philosophy 06 seats, Materia Medica 06 seats, Repertory 06 seats, Pharmacy 06 seats, Practice of medicine 06 seats, Pediatrics 06 seats and Psychiatry 06 seats for the academic year 2024-25. The College Part I information has been received for information on compliance to MSR 2013. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Standards Requirements to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the Part I information submitted by the college and the report of the conducted inspection done on 1/08/2024 and 2/8/2024, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed the following shortfalls.

1. **Miscellaneous**

- Adhaar enabled biometric attendance system (AEBAS) is not implemented. This may be enabled within a period of one month.
- Herbal garden is not maintained properly.
- The library seems to be non-functioning, and it is situated in between 2 floors of boys hostel. All books in Departmental libraries are issued from the central library stock itself without any issue register. Books were not arranged properly in most of the racks. There is no sitting and working area for the three librarians. Damaged books are not discarded from the library. Being a PG institute Library and Information department shall be developed with proper documentation of available books and publication etc. Accession register may be updated. WIFI facility and digital scientific platforms may be made available for faculties and students.

2. **Teaching faculty**

- a) 10 UG faculty and 11 PG faculty were absent on 2nd day of Inspection and no leave application were provided in support of leave.
- b) Many of the teaching faculties have no proper information about their concerned department.
- c) Most of the teaching laboratories are not maintained properly like- sanitation and cleanliness.

- d) Most of the teaching departments are poorly ventilated.
  - e) Two UG classrooms out of five are smaller than the intake capacity i.e: 100.
- 3. Hospital**
- a) 02 patients from Male ward have claimed that their blood samples were not collected but lab reports were attached in their IPD files.
  - b) OT register, autoclave register, and fumigation register are not provided.
  - c) On duty Nursing staff on the visitation day were not as per the duty roster. Most of the nursing staff do not have appropriate qualifications.
  - d) College is running ICU, but one ICU patient had undergone total abdominal hysterectomy on 28/07/2024 and in her USG report on 29/07/24 suggests- Bulky uterus with fibroid. USG report was generated by the attached hospital.
  - e) All the OPD rooms are stuffy, poorly ventilated and low height. No facility is provided for hand washing and wash basin.
  - f) Clinical laboratory does not follow BMW protocol, expired serological kits were kept in huge numbers. There were two lab technicians but on physical verification one person is totally changed.
  - g) There are two buildings in the hospital block and none of them have lift and emergency Exit. The ramp facility for the disabled and aged patient have not been implemented in Hospital.
  - h) The cleaning and hygiene and sanitation of the entire hospital is not up to the mark.
  - i) There is no AERB certification of the radiology unit of the attached hospital.

IPD and OPD case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, Address, Phone number, etc. Diagnosis of the case shall be recorded as per ICD 11 criteria. All follow-up attendance should be recorded on the case records. Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case history, analysis and evaluation and repertorisation as per Homoeopathic Principles and made available in the Medical Record Room for academic purposes of students and follow up of patients.

Considering the above observations and facilities available, MARBH has decided to issue Conditional Permission to G.D Memorial Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital East Ram Krishna Nagar, P.O. Jaganpura for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats reduced from 100 seats in BHMS for the academic year 2024-2025. College have been granted with 42 seats in PG in 07 subjects namely Homoeopathic Philosophy 6 seats, Materia Medica 6 seats, Repertory 6 seats, Pharmacy 6 seats, Practice of medicine 6 seats, Pediatrics 6 seats and Psychiatry 6 seats have been granted for the academic year 2024-2025.

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

It is further to mention that all admissions shall be made from NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15% of post-graduate of the permitted intake capacity of 75 UG seats and 42 PG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State/UT Govt as designated by Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT.

The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/ AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.

If the College is aggrieved with the above decision, College may place an appeal to the National Commission for Homoeopathy as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulation 2024, section 14 sub-section (3) and NCH (General Regulations) 2023, section 22 within a period of 30 days.
